Educational objective:	Information introducing the issue of stereotype, the way it is perceived, the nature of the national stereotype and the basic stereotypes of the Czech nation.

Time needed:	1 unit (45 minutes)		
Description of activity:	At the start, a brainstorming will take place to determine the level of student pre-concepts in the field stereotypes and national stereotypes. It is also possible to use drawing using concept maps. The following is an explanation of teacher using a presentation in which the teacher explains the the origins and the current view on the topic of stereotypes, national stereotypes and meet with the most common stereotypes about Czechs as a nation. The last part represents a feedback discussion of students and explanation of their questions.

Own reflections:	Students will be introduced in deeper understanding of how stereotypes are created, what causes their use, and how national stereotypes are created. Subsequent discussion with students can help to break down some prejudices or misconceptions through concrete examples. At the end, there is a feedback with student's reflection, on which students can verify the amount of memorized information from the presentation.
