Name of activity:	WORLD WAR I IN THE CZECH LITERATURE – JAROSLAV HAŠEK		
Educational objective:	Information presenting the personality of Jaroslav Hašek and his most famous anti-war novel The Fate of the Good Soldier Švejk during the World War. Students will learn about excerpts from the work and reflect on their own perception of the book.		
Qualities in focus:	Literature, Civic responsibility,		
Target group, age of the students:	19 th years of age (tertiary education)		
Suitable for:	Literature Civics Educational area: Man and Society Educational field: Citizenship education		
Teaching aids, preparation:	PC, dataprojector, whiteboards for brainstorming and mind mapping		
Time needed:	1 unit (45 minutes)		
Description of activity:	At the start, a brainstorming will take place to determine the level of student pre-concepts in the field of World War 1 in the Czech literature. Afterwards, the teacher will introduce students to the personality of Jaroslav Hašek through a worksheet and students will analyse excerpts from the texts and video clips. Finally, they will analyse and debate the interview on the book The Fate of the Good Soldier Švejk during the World War and defend their possible different positions through a confrontational discussion. The last part represents a feedback discussion of students and explanation of their questions.		
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Own reflections:	Students will gain a deeper insight into the reflection of World War I in Czech literature through a satirical perspective. Through a confrontational defense of their views on the book, they can reinforce their opinions and attitudes on the subject of the war. At the end, there is a feedback with student's reflection, on which students can verify the amount of memorized information from the worksheet.
