Time needed:	1 unit (45 minutes)			
Description of activity:	At the start, a brainstorming will take place to determine the level of student pre-concepts in the field of gender. Afterwards, the teacher will introduce students with the the general view of today's society on women, the reflections of gender issues in contemporary education and the general opinion of the society on the position of women in politics. The last part represents a feedback discussion of students and explanation of their questions.			
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Own reflections:	Students will gain a deeper insight into the reflection of gender during the history and from the current point of view. With using the information in the presentation, students can reinforce their opinions and attitudes on the issue of gender and its understanding in Europe. At the end, there is a feedback with student's reflection, on which students can verify the amount of memorized information from the presentation.
