Name of activity:	IMMIGRANTS IN THE BRITISH SCHOOL SYSTEM			
Educational objective:	Basic information about the current situation of immigrants within the British education system. Suggestions are presented for current solutions that the EU can learn from in the context of the refugee influx. The issue of refugees and students' views on it are discussed.

Target group, age of the students:		19 <sup>th</sup> years of age (tertiary education)

Teaching aids, preparation:	PC, dataprojector, whiteboards for brainstorming and mind mapping			
Time needed:	1 unit (45 minutes)			
Description of activity:	At the start, a brainstorming will take place to determine the level of student pre-concepts in the field of immigration and solutions for immigrants in higher education in Europe and in the UK. Afterwards, the teacher will introduce students with the basic information about immigrants within the British education system and with the possible solutions for immigrants at British universities. Following discussion is focused on the opinions of student on immigration and solutions in their country.			
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Own reflections:	Students will gain a deeper insight into the current situation of immigrants at UK universities. As a part of discussion, they can share their own experiences with the diversity and inclusion at their school. At the end, there is a feedback with student's reflection, on which students can verify the amount of memorized information from the presentation.
