Educational objective:	Information giving an up-to-date overview of British universities (after Brexit), the possibilities of studying here and describing the conditions for foreign nationals to study at British schools.			
Qualities in focus:		Civic responsibility		
Target group, age of the students:		18 <sup>th</sup> years of age (secondary education)		
Suitable for:		Civics Educational area: Man and Society Educational field: Citizenship education		
Teaching aids, preparation:	PC, dataprojector, whiteboards for brainstorming and mind mapping			
Time needed:	1 unit (45 minutes)			
Description of activity:	At the start, a brainstorming will take place to determine the level of student pre-concepts in the field of British Universities and the possibility of studying here as a foreign national. Afterwards, the teacher will introduce students with the basic information about the British educational system and with the possibilities for study of foreign students. Following discussion is focused on the opinions of student on views on British education and awareness of the opportunities for their involvement not only in their studies but also in school life.			
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Own reflections:	Students will gain a deeper insight into the current situation of British school system (after Brexit). As a part of discussion, they can share their own experiences with the study abroad. At the end, there is a feedback with student's reflection, on which students can verify the amount of memorized information from the presentation.
