<b>Name of activity:</b>	<b>THE THEORY AND TRANSFORMATION OF CITIZENSHIP EDUCATION</b>		
<b>Educational objective:</b>	Additional information about the theory and transformation of the world citizenship education. Frontal teaching with student's feedback to obtain primary information. A view of citizenship education as a discipline in relation to educational theory.		
<b>Qualities in focus:</b>	Civic responsibility		
<b>Target group, age of the students:</b>	18+ years of age (university)		
<b>Suitable for:</b>	Civics, National History Educational area: Man and Society Educational field: Citizenship education		
<b>Teaching aids, preparation:</b>	PC, dataprojector, whiteboards for brainstorming and mind mapping		
<b>Time needed:</b>	1 unit (45 minutes)		
<b>Description of activity:</b>	<p>At the start, a brainstorming will take place to determine the level of student pre-concepts in the field of world educational theory. It is also possible to use drawing using concept maps.</p> <p>The following is an explanation of teacher using a presentation in which the teacher explains the history and development of citizenship education in relation to educational theory.</p> <p>The last part represents a feedback discussion of students and explanation of their questions.</p>		
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<b>Own reflections:</b>	Students will be acquainted with the history and development of world educational theory and citizenship education. At the end, there is a feedback with student's reflection, on which students can verify the amount of memorized information from the presentation.
