<b>Name of activity:</b>	<b>ETHICAL FOUNDATIONS OF HUMAN RIGHTS</b>		
<b>Educational objective:</b>	Basic information introducing a general description of human rights and the modern concept of human rights in Europe.

<b>Target group, age of the students:</b>	15-16 <sup>th</sup> years of age (secondary school)

<b>Time needed:</b>	1 unit (45 minutes)		
<b>Description of activity:</b>	<p>At the start, a brainstorming will take place to determine the level of student pre-concepts in the field of human rights. It is also possible to use drawing using concept maps.</p> <p>The following is an explanation of teacher using a presentation in which the teacher explains the history and development of the human rights and introduce the modern concept of human rights in Europe.</p> <p>The last part represents a feedback discussion of students and explanation of their questions.</p>
