Description of activity:	At the start, a brainstorming will take place to determine the level of student pre-concepts in the field of human rights. The following is an explanation of teacher using a presentation in which the teacher explains the history and development of the human rights and introduce the modern concept of human rights in Europe. The last part represents a feedback discussion of students and explanation			
	of their questions.			
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Own reflections:	Students will be acquainted with the history and development of human rights and meet the aspects of the modern concept of human rights in Europe. At the end, there is a feedback with student's reflection, on which students can verify the amount of memorized information from the presentation.
