Time needed:	1 unit (45 minutes)			
Description of activity:	At the start, a brainstorming will take place to determine the level of student pre-concepts in the field of social relations and values, such as moral criteria, recognition of right and wrong, justice and injustice. It is also possible to use drawing using concept maps. The following is an explanation of teacher using a presentation in which the teacher explains the history and development of ethics and social ethics in Europe. The last part represents a feedback discussion of students and explanation of their questions.			
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Own reflections:	Students will be acquainted with the history and development of ethics and social ethics and meet the aspects of values and value awareness in the current Europe. At the end, there is a feedback with student's reflection, on which students can verify the amount of memorized information from the presentation.
